

Thermostatic Cartridge

Your Steam shower is fitted with a Thermostatic Core/Cassette. Should you need to remove or replace the cassette for maintenance or replacement, follow the instructions below.

BEFORE STARTING ENSURE THAT THE WATER & ELECTRICAL SUPPLIES ARE DISCONNECTED.

It is imperative that you check and ensure that the water supply to your unit is balanced with a pressure of between 1 and 3 bar as an imbalance will damage the core.



Remove the temperature selector knob. Remove the chrome coloured plug in the dial to allow access to the Alan grub screw inside. Loosen the dial until it removes easily.



Remove the plastic temperature guard from the brass spline exposing the head of the core.



Unscrew chrome Temperature face plate as shown.

Remove the retaining grub screw, then using pipe grips as shown in photo, twist the thermo stat core left and right whilst pulling it from its housing. (It is held in position by a rubber washer so you will feel it pop out of position)



Refitting the new thermostat is a reversal of the above. Smart Price Warehouse showers are fitted with one of two types of Thermostatic Cartridge. If you need to replace your cartridge/cassette, please compare yours with the two below when requesting a replacement. It is important that you identify the correct cassette, as fitting the wrong cassette type may damage your Shower and invalidate your Warranty.

SHOWER WATER TEMPERATURE

If you find that the desired water temperature cannot be achieved even when turning the dial to a hottest setting this indicates that the Thermostatic Cartridge has failed. This typically indicates that the water pressures to your cabin are **IMBALANCED**, to rectify this you need to get a plumber to balance the water pressures to your cabin and reset your Thermostatic Cartridge.
